

TOURNAMENT RULES

Under 13

(Binding version is the original Italian version)

1. Category

All players born after 01/01/2012 and all female players born after 01/01/2011 are eligible to play. At the start of the tournament, the 'MyHockey player list' or copies of the identification documents as well as the player list of the players called up must be submitted to the organisers.

2. Programme

The tournament is divided into three phases, a preliminary round, a play-off round and a final round.

The 6 participating teams are divided into a single round in the preliminary round. Each team plays five matches against the other teams.

The teams in 5th and 6th place take part directly in the final round to determine 5th and 6th place.

The four best-placed teams in the preliminary round compete against each other in a play-off round. First against fourth, second against third. The two losers then meet to determine 3rd and 4th place, and the two winners meet to determine 2nd and 1st place.

3. Team composition

The games are played with 5 outfield players and 1 goalkeeper. Each team consists of a maximum of 17 players (including goalkeepers).

4. <u>Type of game</u>

- Preliminary round:

The games are played in **two periods of 15 minutes each**, with a break of 3 minutes, without retreat to the dressing room. The first **12 minutes of the playing time are without time interruption** *(except in the case of a penalty)* and the last 3 minutes are effective playing time (with time interruption) of each half of the game. **Each period counts as 'one game'**.

- Play-off round:

Games are played in **two periods of 15 minutes each**, with a 3 minute intermission, with no retreat to the dressing room. The first **12 minutes of the playing time are without time interruption** (except in the case of a penalty) and the last 3 minutes are effective playing time (with time interruption) of each half of the game. Each period counts as 'one game'. If each team wins a half, a further 5-minute half (O.T.) is played, without time interruption (except in the case of a penalty), except for the last minute (with time interruption) and with the golden goal. In the event of a further draw, 3 penalty shots will be taken.

- Final round:

The games of the final rounds are played in two periods of 15 minutes each with a break of 3 minutes. The first 27 minutes are played without interruption *(except in the case of a penalty)*. The last 3 minutes of the second half of the game are effective playing time *(with time interruption)*.

5. <u>Referees and penalties</u>

The referees' decisions are final.

Penalties are imposed in all games in accordance with the SEHV rules. The exception is the duration of penalties, half of the official penalty minutes are served. (2 penalty minutes = 1 penalty minute to be served).

The tournament committee may exclude a player, a coach or an assistant for one or more games in the event of serious offences.

6. Scoring and ranking

For each match in the preliminary round, 2 points are awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a defeat or forfeit (with a final score of 0-5). The preliminary ranking is based on the following criteria: Number of points, direct match, goal difference (*from all matches*), number of goals scored, draw. If the result of the final match is a draw at the end of the playing time, a penalty shoot-out will be held to determine the winner. Each team has 3 shots to shoot. If the game is still tied, further penalties are taken until a decisive goal is scored (*equal number of shots per team*).

7. Award ceremony

All participating teams will receive a prize. Participation in the award ceremony is mantadory Chiasso, October 2024
